



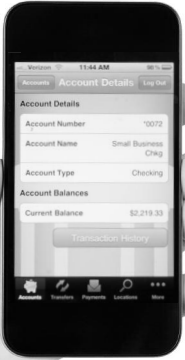

Mary Susan Burich was born on February 18, 1915, in Silver Lake, Minnesota. "Mary and I had known each other while we were growing up," said Irv Burich in a Leader interview. "She went away to boarding school in Mankato. When she came back, we started doing things together. We decided when I was making \$100 a month, we could get married. When I was making \$90 a month, which was three years after starting at Citizens Bank in Hutchinson, we figured that was close enough." They shared 62 years of marriage until Irv passed away on April 12, 2002.



Mary was truly the woman behind the man supporting Irv in all civic and banking endeavors. "Where you found Dad, you found Mom," Buzz Burich said. Throughout the years that the Burichs owned Citizens Bank, Mary was a true friend to the CB employees. Her smile and elegance have provided us with many great memories.
