○ "SKIP THE TRIP" TO THE BANK WITH MOBILE DEPOSIT!

Now you can "skip the trip" to the bank with Mobile Deposit on your smart phone! Make sure you have signed up for CB Online Banking before downloading the mobile app. Simply search iTunes or Google play for "Touch Banking" and use the app code: "gomobile0315".

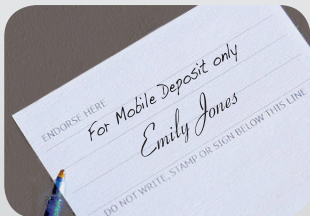


Side 1: full front side

- Mobile Deposit allows you to make deposits up to \$3,000 per day and \$1,500 per check.
- There is no charge! You can deposit as many checks as you like below the \$3,000 daily maximum. Wireless message and data rates may also apply.
- Once your deposit has posted to your account, our normal funds availability policy will apply. Cutoff time for Mobile Deposit will be 4:00 p.m. Typically it takes 24 hours for the funds to become available. If you are depositing over the weekend, please allow 24 hours from the first business day of the week.
- Please keep the checks in a safe place for 30 calendar days after you see the check deposited in your account. This is to assure that you have the check until it has gone through the check collection system. After that, dispose of the check securely - we recommend cross-cut shredding.
